Please acknowledge and cite the use of FIMS-SPEAR data. MAST suggests the following:

- Include the acknowledgement text provided on the [Mission Acknowledgements](#) page under "FIMS-SPEAR".
- Cite the Digital Object Identifier (DOI) for FIMS-SPEAR at MAST, [10.17909/dsbe-kj54](https://doi.org/10.17909/dsbe-kj54). Useful TeX syntax for citing DOIs can be found at the [MAST DOI guide](#) in the FAQ.
- Consider citing the main mission papers:

 - [Seon et al. 2011](#)
- If your research is based on the SPEAR specially-reduced observations of the Vela supernova remnant, consider citing [Nishikida et al. 2006](#).
- If your research is based on the FIMS extracted stellar spectra, consider citing [Jo et al. 2016](#).
